## THE WEST AVIAT GOLF CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

On joining the Club, each member voluntarily submits to acceptable standards of behaviour and ethical conduct. Members are under an obligation to avoid acts that are unsporting or discredit the game or our club. The Committee of Management has the power to take any disciplinary action against:

- Any member who whilst within the precincts of the tavern/pro-shop or on the golf course engages in conduct that is detrimental to the spirit of the game or general behaviour that is deemed to be unacceptable;
- Any member who at any time physically abuses any opponent or other person within the precincts of the course or tavern/pro-shop;
- Any members who unreasonably uses profane or abusive language, throws or breaks clubs, or willfully damages any portion of the golf course in any way;
- Any member who acts in such a way that brings discredit to the West Aviat Golf Club or the game of golf in general, either within the confines of the golf club, or while representing the golf club at other courses or in any open public forums (e.g. social media);
- Any member who commits a criminal offence against the Club or its members, e.g. assault, damage or theft of Club/member's property;
- Any member who refuses to comply with the Club Dress Code;
- Any member who fails to ensure that their guest(s) comply with the Club's Code of Conduct;
- Any club member who is abusive and disrespectful to any employee of the Hillview Golf Course whom is trying to undertake their job as instructed by the Hillview Golf Course Management.

Any member who witnesses any breach of this Code will be obliged to co-operate in any subsequent inquiry. Any such violations of the Code of Conduct, if successfully pursued may attract penalties ranging from reprimand, suspension of playing rights or expulsion from the club as determined by the Committee.
